



## Communiqué de Presse

The Mayor of Paris, Anne Hidalgo, will speak at the end of the debate Monday, June 23 at 17:20 at the Forum Live in a Living City which will be be held at the Maison de la RATP.

In his first major speech on the subject since his election, the Mayor of Paris will deliver its program of work and its commitments for the term of office during which  $\in$  1 billion will be spent on the transformation of Paris in a smart and sustainable metropolis.

Live in a living City aims to be the French annual high-level trans disciplinary meeting which will allow to share reflections, experiences including the actors from all the fields, to build together, today, the life of the city, the city of tomorrow and the living city.

Organized under the patronage of the Academy of Technology, UN-HABITAT and the Ministry of Ecology, Sustainable Development and Energy, the Forum will be structured around two principles:

- Scientific excellence with the participation of about 10 personalities of the highest world level who will exchange during a day around a multimedia corner completed by local and international guests from the ubiquitous world and to interact spontaneously, in real time connected by internet with others participants. Documentaries and videos will illustrate their points.
- Separate rooms dedicated for thematic workshops in which the actors from innovation and urban intelligence field will exchange with the public
